Commissioners Order No. 4

The Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Avon met at the House of James Jones in said Town of this 1st day of July 1847 at 8 o'clock in the forenoon to take into consideration the subject of the petition of Daniel Smith and 12 others for the laying of a public Highway it being proved to our satisfaction that such notice of our meeting had been given as the law requires. We proceeded to examine the ground on the route petitioned for and caused a survey to be made: Commencing at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Post 31 Chains and 39 Links South of the Northwest corner of Town 1 Range 10: thence running East on the $\frac{1}{4}$ line to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Post on the East line of Sect. 6 thence N. $68\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 73 Chains :thence N. 61° E. 28 Chains and 60 links to the North line of the Town same course in Town 2 Range 10, 4 Chains and 80 links thence N. $81\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 37 Chains and 50 links; thence South 75° E. 11 Chains to the Town line:thence East on the Town line to the North East corner of Sec. 4:thence East on the Town line to the North East Corner of Town 1 Range 10.

And we Order and Determine that the above described line be the center line of a Public Highway of 4 rods in width as far as the North line of the Town at a point 17 Chains from the North West corner of Section 4 and we further order that the North line of said Town be the centre line of a Highway of which two Rods in width is to be taken from the said Town of Avon Commencing 11 Chains and 4 links West from the North East corner of Section 4: thence running East to the North East Corner of Town 1 Range 10.
