Commissioners Order No.2

The Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Avon met at the house of Enoch Beals this 3rd day of July 1848 at 8 o'clock A.M. to take into consideration the subject of the petition of John Kennedy and 8 others for the laying of a public highway it being proved to our satisfaction that such notice of our meeting had been given as the law requires. We proceeded to examine the ground on the route petitioned for and caused a survey to be made: Commencing on the Town Line between Avon and Spring Valley at the Section Stake between Section 2 and 3: thence South on the Section line between 10 and 11 and 14 and 15 until it intersects the Beloit and Monroe road. And we order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Public Highway of four Rods in width.
