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Supervisors Order No.2
Avon March 4th 1850

We the Supervisors in and for the Town of Avon Met this fourth day of March A.D. 1850 to take into consideration the subject of a petition for a Highway Commencing at the South East corner of Section sixteen after being satisfied that such notice had been given as the law requires we proceeded to examine the rout and caused a survey of the same to be made as follows: Beninning at the South East corner of Section sixteen: thence running South on the Section line to the quarter post on the East side of section twenty one:thence South 45° East 28 Chains and 16 links to the center of the South West quarter of Section 22: thence East 104 Chains thence South 17° East 16,50 Sixteen chains and fifty links: thence South 40°,30 degrees thirty minutes East 10 chains: thence South 27° East 9 Chains: thence South 37°,30 minutes East 8 Chains:thence South 1° East 20 Chains: thence South 33 degrees East 18 Chains: thence South 60° East 15 chains:thence South 47 3/4° East 8 Chains: thence North 77° East to the North East corner of Section 36 Town 1 Range 10. And we order and determine that the above discribed line be the centre line of a Highway of four rods in width.
