We the undersigned Supervisors of the town of Avon in the County of Rock having by an order bearing date the 15th day of July A.D. 1865, upon due application for that purpose, laid out a highway as follows; Commencing at the North West corner of Section 17 it being also the South West corner of Section 8 township 1 North of Range 10 East, then running East on Section line two hundred and twenty eight 228 rods; thence South two rods, thence East 12 rods, until it intersects the North and South road running to the village of Avon. Certain owners of lands through which said highway is laid out, to wit: William Brown. Chat Goodhue & Co. Ben. Brace and Rufus Breed not having released all claims to damages sustained by reason of the laying out and opening of said highway and not being able to agree with them as to the amount of such damages, having applied to them for that purpose and endeavoured to make such a agreement we did proceed and assess the damages which such owners would sustain by reason of the laying out of such highway through their lands, as follows: To William Brown on the West half of the S.W. quarter of Sec. 8 T.1 N. R 10 E. we have awarded the sum of fifty cents. To Charles Goodhue & Co. on the North West quarter of Sec. 17 T. 1 N. of R.10 E. we have awarded the sum of fifty cents. To B. T. Brace on the S.E. quarter of the S.W. quarter, and on the S.W. quarter of the S.E. quarter of Sec. 8 Town 1 N. of R 10 E. \$60.00 as damages to said lands. To Rufus Breed on the N.W. quarter of the N.E. quarter of Sec. 17 T. 1 N. of R. 10 we have awarded the sum of Sixty dollars as damages to said land.
