

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Avon for the laying out of a Public Road as herein after described we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 29th day of May 1872 make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 10th day of June 1872 at 2 o'clock P.M. of said day at the S.E. corner of the S.E.¼ of the S.W¼ of Section No. 15 it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice and having first been satisfied that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands through which said public Road passes and had also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting in the manner required by law we did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway and did hear all reasons that were offered for or against laying out the same and did decide upon such application and it being our opinion that the public good will thereby be promoted did decide to lay out said Public Road as hereinafter described. Now therefore pursuant to said application we the said Supervisors do hereby order and determine that a public road be and the same is hereby laid out as follows to wit: Commencing at the S.E. corner of the S.E. quarter of the South West ¼ of Section 15 thence running North on the line between the South west quarter of the South east quarter and the South East quarter of the South West quarter to the South West corner of the North West of the South East quarter of Section No. 15 Town 1 North of Range 10 E. the same being an accurate survey thereof caused by us to be made the line of survey is the center of said highway and the same is laid out of the width of three rods.
