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Surveyed for the Beloit and Monroe road from the east line of Section 15 Westerly to the West line of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section: commencing at a point on the East line of said Section, two chains and 43 links South: thence North 55° West (on a variation of $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$) 3.43 Chains, to the North line of said Section: thence West on said North line, to the West line of said East $\frac{1}{2}$ of N. E $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section. The above described lines to be the center line of said road and the road to be four rods wide.

Of which land $\frac{448}{1000}$ of an acre is now enclosed by fence with the land on the North of said line, and $\frac{78}{1000}$ of an acre on the West side of Kelley's East Yard $\frac{1000}{1000}$ fence, which is included in the first stated-buried a hard-head stone 12x11x8 at angle of road.
