

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY BELOIT TO SUGAR RIVER

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock and Territory of Wisconsin holden at the dwelling house of Hugh Lee in said town on the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three; two of the said Commissioner having met and deliberated on the subject embraced in the following order. It is ordered and determined that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods leading from the Village of Beloit to Sugar River. Said highway is to pass through land not enclosed, improved or cultivated and the said Commissioners have caused a survey to be made as follows: Commencing on the upper public landing in the Village of Beloit at the end of the bridge across Rock River, the center line runs North 30° West on the center of said bridge and to a stake in a line with the South side of John Hackett's Stone dwelling house 8 chains-- thence N. 51° W. 4.50 chains; thence S. 89° W. 21.50 chains-- thence N. 75° 45' W. 199.50 chains; thence N. 71° 30' W. 33 chains; thence due West 35 chains to hickory tree; thence S. 9.75 chains; thence West on line between Sections 30 and 31 73.50 chains; thence N. 64½° W. 12.25 chains; thence N. 73° W. 45 chains; thence N. 53° W. 92.50 chains; thence N. 73° W. chains; thence N. 84° W. 35 chains; thence N. 61° W. 14 thence S. 84° W. 20 chains; thence N. 75° W. 28 chains; W. 14.30 chains; thence S. 50° W. 68° W. 41.75 chains; thence thence N. 74° W. 27.80 chains; thence N. 87° W. 9.15 chains; thence W. 12.75 chains; thence N. 87° W. 37.75 chains; N. 74° W. 25.50 chains; thence South 77° W. 35.25 chains; thence N. 53° W. 121.25 chains; thence N. 70° W. 44.75 chains; thence N. 64½° W. 49 chains; thence N. 73° W. 39.50 chains; thence N. 54¼° W. 17 chains; thence N. 44½° W. 18.25 chains; thence 85° W. 37.62 chains; thence N. 73¼° W. 36.38 chains; thence W. 21 chains; thence S. 68° W. 14 chains; thence N. 89-¼° thence S. 65° W. 29 chains to a Burr Oak 16 inch diameter bearing S. 70° E. 5.67 chains from S.E. corner Sec. 8, T. 1, R. 10

ORDERS FOR HIGHWAYS

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Beloit, County of Rock and Territory of Wisconsin holden at the dwelling house of Hugh Lee in said town on the first day of September in the year of our Lord 1843, two of the said Commissioners having met and deliberated on the subject embraced in the following order.

It is ordered and determined that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of three rods on the application of Isaac Teague through whose improved land the said highway is to pass for a part of its distance. The residue of said highway being through land not enclosed, improved or cultivated--and the said commissioners have caused a survey to be made as follows.

The centerline beginning at a point 28 rods from the quarter section post in the South line of Section 32, Township 1 of Range 12 East 1½ rods North of said South line; thence running North 89° 45' West to the centerline of said Section 28 rods. then commencing 1½ rods East of said quarter section post and running North 2° East parallel with the centerline of said section 354¼ rods to a stake standing in the center of the highway leading from the village of Beloit to Monroe. (Magnetic Variation 6° East)

It is also ordered and determined that a highway be laid out of the width of three rods on the South side of the Southwest quarter of Section 32, in T. 1 n., R. 12 E. on application of Samuel M. Drake through whose land said highway is to pass. And the said Commissioners have caused a survey to be made as follows: The center line--commencing 1½ rods North of the Southeast corner of said quarter section; thence running North 89° 45' W. to a point 1¼ rods North of the Southwest corner of said section 160 rods.
