

ORDER FOR HIGHWAYS

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock and Territory of Wisconsin holden on the bridge over Rock River in said town on Monday the 3rd day of June 1844 of which legal notice was given. It is ordered and determined that the following described line be the center of a highway of the width of four rods, to wit:

Beginning at the point where the road from Beloit to Janesville on the West side of Rock River crosses the quarter section line running East and West through Section 35 in Township 1 of Range 12; thence running West on the quarter lines of Sections 35, 34, 33, 32, and 31, 30 3/4 chains to Coon Creek; thence North 53° W. to the road from Beloit to Sugar River 74.58 chains passing corner of Sections 30 & 31. at 67.60.

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the town of Beloit in the County of Rock and Territory of Wisconsin holden on the bridge over Rock River in said town on Monday the third day of June 1844, it is ordered and determined that the following line shall be the center of a highway of the width of four rods to wit:

Beginning at a point in a line with the center of the bridge over Rock River and East of and in a line with the South side of John Hackett's dwelling house; thence N. 51° West 5.19 chains to Post 1; thence N. 1/4° East 51.75 chains to the North line of Section 35; the North 14° West 27.50 chains to the North side of dry channel; thence North 25° West 20 chains; thence North 20° West 55.56 chains to Post 2 miles; thence same course 80 chains to Post 3 miles; thence same course 80 chains to Post 4 miles; thence same course 80 chains to Post 5 miles; thence same course 32 chains to bridge in a highway from the Village of Beloit to Janesville, surveyed Sept. 23, 24, 25th, 1841.

It is also ordered and determined that the following described line of road discontinued to wit: Beginning at a stake on the West Bank of Rock River which stake bears N. 12° W. from the North center window of Rood's store; thence N. 12° W. 1 mi. and 15 chains; thence N. 18 1/2° W. 2 miles and 5 chains; thence N. 26° W. 1 mi. and 5 chain to a large White Oak tree; thence N. 34° W. 41 chains; thence N. 4° E. 23 chains to section line, 15 chains and 20 links North of the corner of Sections 3, 4, 9, 10 of T. 1 N. of R. 12 E. of 4th P.M.; thence N. 1/4° E. 29 chains.

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit holden at the house of S. M. Drake in said town on the 8th day of March in the year of our Lord 1844 -- it is ordered and determined that the following described line running through land not enclosed, improved or cultivated which we have caused to be surveyed shall be the center of a highway four rods in width. to wit:

Beginning on the line between the North and South half of Section 34 in Township 1 of Range 12 East where the highway from the Village of Beloit to Sugar River crosses said line; thence running West on said line (crossing section line at 71.70 chains) 80 chains to post mark 1 mi.; thence same course on center line of Section 33 (passing quarter post at 71.60 chains) 80 chains to post marked 2 mi.; thence same course on centerline of Section 32 (passing quarter post at 71.60 chains) 80 chains to post marked 3 mi.; thence same course to Coon Creek 17 chains; thence North 53° West 63 chains to post marked 4mi.; Same Course (passing corner of Section 30 and 31 at 4.60 chains) 11.60 chains to the highway running from the Village of Beloit to Sugar River.
