ORDER NO. 3

OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS

FOR HIGHWAY FROM MADISON ROAD TOWARDS JANESVILLE

1844-5

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock and Territory of Wisconsin holden at the stone mill in Beloit at ten o'clock A.M. of the third day of March A. D. 1845.

To take into consideration the subject of the petition of L. G. Fisher and eleven other for a highway to be laid out; the said Commissioners being satisfied that notice of this meeting had been given as the law required and having examined the route and caused a survey of the same to be made, do order that the following described line be the center line of a highway of the width of four rods to wit: Beginning at the center of the East end of School Street in the Village of Beloit; thence running North 87° East 4 chains to angle; thence South 43¼° East 21 chains to a highway leading from Beloit to Clinton.

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highway for the Town of Beloit holden at the house of Eleazer McKinster in said town on Wednesday the 18th day of June 1845 at ten o'clock A. M. to consider the subject of the petition of E. A. Norris and eight others---it was proved to the satisfaction of the Commissioners that notices of this meeting had been posted up as the law requires---then the Commissioners proceeded to examine the ground on the line petitioned for and caused a survey of the same to be made. The description of the line is as follows:

Beginning at an angle post in a road from Pecatonica to Madison 71 chains Northeast from a school house and on land owned by E. McKinster and running North 33° East 77 chains to the North line of the Town of Beloit at the North corners of Section 1 of Town 1, Range 11 and Section 6 of Town 1, Range 12---which we order and determine shall be the center of a highway of four rods in width.
