

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

The Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark and Beloit met at the Northwest corner of Section 19, Town 1, Range 12 for the purpose of examining the ground for a highway on the West line of the Northwest quarter of said section. It being the line between the said towns****and after being satisfied that notice of this meeting had been given as the law directs by P. H. Green, one of the 13 petitioners, proceeded to examine the ground and do hereby order that the West line of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 19, Township 1 Range 12 shall be the centerline of a highway of three rods in width.

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit hereby certify that we met at the house of S. M. Drake in said town on this 29th day of February A.D. 1848 at ten o'clock in the forenoon for the purpose of taking into consideration the subject of the application of J. M. Keep and fourteen others (six of whom we know and are freeholders of said town) for a highway on the quarter section line of Section 31 in said town and after it had been proved to our satisfaction by the affidavit of Edwin T. Lumes that notice of our meeting at the time and place aforesaid had been given as the law requires we proceeded to examine the ground on the route applied for and finding it passed through lands not enclosed, improved or cultivated and being satisfied of the necessary of having a road leading Eastward from the quarter section post mentioned in the aforesaid application. We do hereby order and determine that the quarter section line running Eastward from the West line of Section 31 in the Town of Beloit to the road from the Village of Beloit to Sugar River 32.75 chains shall be the center line of a highway of the width of four rods
