

ORDERS FOR HIGHWAYS

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Beloit held at the dwelling house of Thos. Holland on the 23rd day of October A.D. 1848 at ten o'clock A.M. for the purpose of deliberating upon this petition of Thos. A. Power and five others (all being freeholders in the said town) to lay out a highway commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 27 of Town 1 North, Range 12 East and thence running West upon the section line and terminating at the Southwest corner of Section 30 of Town 1 North, Range 12 East.

We hereby certify that upon being satisfied upon the affidavit of Hugh Lee that notice of our meeting at such time and place had been given as the law directs and requires, it is ordered and determined by said Commissioners that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods the section line to be the center of said highway commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 27 of Town 1 North, Range 12 East and running thence West four miles to the Southwest corner of Section 30 of Town 1, North of Range 12 East. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands at Beloit on the 23rd day of October 1848.

ORDER FOR HIGHWAYS

The undersigned Commissioners appointed by the Legislators of the late Territory of Wisconsin to lay out and establish a territorial road from Beloit in the County of Rock, thence on the nearest and best road to White Oaks Springs in the County of Lafayette crossing the Pecatonic River at or near the Northwest corner of Section 21, T. 1 N., R. 6 have laid the said road according to the said act, that thereof which lies in the town of Beloit is located as follows: To wit - commencing at a point in the center of 4th Street in the Town of Beloit in the West side of Rock River where the quarter section line running East and West through section 35, Town 1, Range 12 crosses it. Running thence on West on the quarter section line half a mile North of the state line 80 chains. Set a mile post - marked 2 miles; thence continuing West on the aforesaid line 80 chains, set a mile post marked 3 mi.; continuing West on the quarter section line 80 chains set a mile post marked 4 mi.; thence West on the aforesaid line 2.6 chains to the East branch of Coon Creek center of bridge; thence North 51° West 1.7 chains to angle 2; thence West 71.15° to the West line of the town at the Northeast corner of Section 36, Town 1, Range 11 at the mile posts, the witness trees which are taken are all marked with a marking iron. The number of miles they are respectively from the Village of Beloit and the witness trees to the angles are also marked with the number of the angles respectively.
