

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

The supervisors of the Town of Beloit met at the house of Thos. Holland on Tuesday the 19th day of February 1850 at ten o'clock A.M. according to previous notice and being satisfied by the affidavit of Ira T. Washburn that the notices had been duly given - proceeded to examine the ground and route for the said proposed road and do hereby order that a road of four rods wide be laid out and established as follows to wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 21; thence running Eastward on the North line of said Section 21 to the corner of Sections 13, 16, 21 & 22; thence Eastward on the North line of Section 22 in the direction of the corner of Section 14, 15, 22 & 23, 77 chains and 66 links to the highway from Beloit to Janesville; thence beginning on the North line of or at the centerline of the East half of Section 21 and running South on the centerline of the East half of Section 21 and running 155 chains and 76 links to the Madison Road - one half of said road to pass over the lands of E. Mackinster, Hazen Cheeney, L. G. Fisher, John Kent and Thos. Holland.

ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

The supervisors of the Town of Beloit met at the office of the Town Clerk according to previous notice and being satisfied by the affidavit S. T. Merrill that notices had been given according to law proceeded to examine the route for highway as applied in the petition of S. T. Merrill and others and do hereby order that a public highway be laid out and established as follows to wit: Commencing at the Eastern termination of Second Street in the village of Beloit; thence running Easterly in the same direction (is South 89° East) through the lands of S. Merriman, Calvin Hall and Edwin Bicknell to the Milwaukee Road said road to be the same width with Second Street (is supposed to be 121 links).

At a joint meeting of the Boards of Supervisors of the Towns of Beloit and Rock to take into consideration the matter of opening a road on the line separating the towns abovementioned. It was decided that said road be declared duly opened.

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 34, in the Town of Rock and running East on the township line to the Southeast corner of the Town of Rock to intersect the road leading from Beloit to Janesville; and that the Eastern portion of the road to the center of Rock River belong to the Town of Beloit for the purposes of improvement and from center of said river to the Western terminces belong to the Town of Rock for the same purposes. The said road to be four rods wide, one half the width to be taken from each town.

At a meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Beloit held pursuant to notice it was decided agreeably to the request of petitioners that a road be declared duly opened, commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 2 in said town, running South on the Western line of said section 2, and Sections 11 and 14, two rods from or beyond the center of Section 14; thence West from the center of said Section 14, 70 rods more or less to intersect the road leading from Beloit to Janesville.
