

And after examining the said highway we the supervisors adjourned to meet at the house of Simon Buble on the 11th day of September 1858 at ten o'clock A.M. of that day for the purpose of deciding upon the said application.

At which time we the supervisors met at the place of adjournment and after farther examination of said highway. We do hereby order that part of the said highway mentioned in said petition and herein before described it altered so that the centerline thereof should be described as follows to wit: Commencing at a point in the quarter line of Section 31, Town 1, Range 12 East, 32 rods West of the East line of said section; thence West on said line to the center of said section; thence North on the quarter line ten chains and 25 links to the center of the Territorial Road.

## ORDER FOR HIGHWAY

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Beloit for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described. We the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 2nd day of July A.D. 1859 meet at the house of A. Jarvis in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application. It being the time and place fixed by us for the purpose, did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same. Did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice fixed therein a time and place at which we could meet and decide upon such application. And the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes. And such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting. It is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application which is as follows to wit: Commencing at a point 50 links North of the South quarter post of Section 6; thence running West on a line parallel with the section line to a point 50 links North of the Southwest corner of Section 6, Town 1, Range 12 East, which line of said survey to be the center of said highway. And the same is established four rods in width. It being in length 153 rods. And we award the damages to Gottern Anderson, the sum of \$50.
