HIGHWAY DAMAGES

highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting. It is ordered and determined that we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof an survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 30, Town 1, Range 12 East, and running thence West upon the section line - one mile passing through lands owned by Hugh Lee, Richard Barry, Geo. A. Gilman, A. Clark, J. B. Moore. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width except the South line to run parallel with said center for one hundred rods then to diverge from the quarter post on the South side of Sec. 30 ten feet in 20 rods to the North so as to the clear Geo. A. Gilman's spring; thence to converge ten feet to the South in 20 rods to the section line; thence on the section line to the terminus.

Whereas a highway has been laid out by the supervisors of the Town of Beloit, County of Rock; beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 30, Town 1 Range, 12 East; thence running West one mile which highway is now particularly described by an order of said supervisors bearing date the 26th day of November 1859 and which highway passes through land of Hugh Lee being known and described as follows: the Southeast quarter of Section 30. Also lands owned by George A. Gilman, known and described as follows: the East half of the Northwest quarter of Section 31. Now therefore it is hereby agreed between the said supervisors and the said Hugh Lee and Geo. A. Gilman that the damages sustained by the said Hugh Lee by reason of the laying out an opening said highway upon his land be liquidated and agreed upon at \$10. Also that the damage sustained by the said Geo. A. Gilman by reason of the laying out and opening said highway upon his lands be liquidated and agreed upon at \$30. In witness whereof the said supervisors and the said Hugh Lee and Geo. A. Gilman have hereunto subscribed their names this day of November 1859.
