before the time of our said meeting - it is ordered and determined that we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application whereof a survey according to the government survey which is as follows to wit: Commencing at the South quarter post of Section 6; thence running West between Sections 6 and 7 to the town line between the towns of Beloit and Newark in Rock County, State of Wisconsin. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.

A RELEASE OF DAMAGES

Whereas a highway been laid out by the supervisors of the Town of Beloit, County of Rock by an order bearing date the 29th day of November 1859 described as follows: Commencing at the South quarter post Section 6 running West on line between Sections 6 and 7, Town 1, Range 12 East to the line between Towns of Beloit and Newark in said county which road passes through certain lands owned by me described as follows - the East half of the S.W.¼ of Section 6. Now therefore know all men by these presents that I, Taurus Saberson, for value do hereby release all claims to damages sustained by me by reason of laying out and opening said highway through my said lands above described. In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 29th day of November 1859.

Whereas a highway has been laid out by the supervisors of the Town of Beloit, County of Rock from the South quarter post of Section 6 to the town line which highway is more particularly described by an order of the supervisors bearing date of November 29th 1859 and which highway passes through land of M. Mahers, being known and described as follows: the West half of the N.W.¼ of Section 7 also land of W. G. Bentley being known and described as follows: The East half of the N.W.¼ of Section 7 also land owned by G. Anderson - being known and described as follows: the West half of the S.W.¼ of Section 6. Now therefore it is hereby agreed between the said supervisors and the said M. Mahers, W. G. Bentley, and G. Anderson - that the damages sustained by reason of the laying out and opening said highway upon their lands be liquidated and agreed upon as follows: M. Mahers at \$22.50; S. G. Bentley at \$22.50. In witness whereof the said supervisors and the said M. Mahers, W. G. Bentley, G. Anderson have hereunto set their hands this 29th day of November 1859.
