Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said Town of Beloit for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described. We the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1860 meet at the house of Stephen C. Millett in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such a application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying the same, did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described. Having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application. And an applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the land through which said highway passes.

AWARD OF DAMAGES ON HIGHWAY LAID OUT BY US, SUPERVISORS

OCTOBER 16<sup>th</sup>, 1860

We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Beloit and County of Rock having by an order bearing date October 16<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1860 upon due application for the purpose laid out a highway as follows: Commencing at the center of Section 8 in said Town of Beloit and running thence West on the quarter section line through Sections 8 and 7 to the Beloit and Madison Road; and the owners of lands through which said highway is laid out to wit: Hugh McGavock, F. Morse, O. R. Bass, J. Mattby, C. Stoddard, R. Irish, W. Morse, A. Jarvis, J. Conley, not having released all claim to damages sustained by reason of laying out and opening of said highway and not being able to agree with them as to the amount of such damages, having applied to them for that purpose and endeavoured to make such arrangement.
