which such owners would sustain by reason of the laying out of such highway through their lands as follows; to wit: To Hugh McGavock for two rods in width off the South side of the Northwest quarter Section 8, \$ 20. To J. F. Morse, for two rods in width off the North end of the East half of S.W.¼ of said Section 8, \$10. To J. Mattby, for two rods in width off the North end of the West half of the S.W.¼ said Section 8, \$10.00. To C. C. Stoddard, for two rods in width of the North end of the East half of the S.E.¼ of Section 7, \$10. To O. R. Bass, for two rods in width off the South end of the East half of the N. E.¼ of Section 7, \$10. T. R. Irish, for two rods in width off the North end of the West half of the S.E.¼ of Section 7, \$15. To W. Morse, for two rods in width off the South end of the West half of the N.E.¼ of Section 7, \$10. To A. Jarvis, for two rods in width off the South end of that part of the West half of the N.E.¼ of Section 7 which lies East of the Beloit and Madison Road, \$5. \$5 also James Conley for two rods in width off the North end of the West half of S.E.¼ of Section 7 which lies East of the Beloit and Madison Road, \$5. All of which above sums we have this day awarded to the above named owners or occupants of said lands. Making a total of \$95.

And it is hereby further ordered that said highway be opened through said lands by the owners or occupants on or before the first day of March next (1861)
