

APPLICATION FOR HIGHWAY

To the supervisors of the Towns of Newark in the County of Rock and Beloit in same county.

We the undersigned freeholders residing in said towns, as stated opposite our respective names hereunder, do hereby make application to you to lay out a highway upon the line between said towns, or as near thereto as the situation of the ground will admit as follows to wit: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 12 in the Town of Newark and the Northwest corner of Section 7 in the Town of Beloit, and running thence due South on the town line until it intersects the Beloit and Madison road, there to terminate of distance some 36 rods. Said highway to pass through or on a part of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 12 in the Town of Newark and the N.W. 1/4 of S the N.W. 1/4 of Section 7 in the Town of Beloit.
