Carr, the occupant of the West half of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Town 1 Range 12 East and Thomas Pritchard, the occupant of the East half of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$  and N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Town 1 Range 12 East being lands through which the highway mentioned is said notice may pass.
