Application having been on the 16th day of August 1890 duly made to the undersigned supervisors of the Towns of Rock and Beloit in the County of Rock by six freeholders from each town residing in said towns for a highway to be laid out as follows to wit: Commencing at the highway crossing at the town line between Rock and Beloit at the Southwest corner of Sec. 35 in the Town of Rock and the Northwest corner of Section 2 of the Town of Beloit; thence West on the line between the Towns of Beloit and Rock to the highway crossing over said town line at or near the Southwest corner of Section 34 in the Town of Beloit and the Northwest corner of Sec. 3 in the Town of Beloit so as to intersect the highway passing through lands as follows:

North half of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 3 in the Town of Beloit and the South half of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 34 in the Town of Rock Belonging to B. C. Crossman and the South half S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 34 in the Town of Rock belonging to Sharpe Bros. and the North half of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 3, Town of Beloit belonging to M. Bowen

Notice is therefore hereby given that we the undersigned supervisor of said towns will meet on the 20th day of Sept. 1890 at ten O'clock in the forenoon of that day at Mr. Bowen's dwelling house in the Town of Beloit and decide upon said application.

We the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Beloit in the County of Rock having by an order duly made by us having dated this 24th day of January A.D. 1889, laid out a public highway to the land of Henry Schmidt the same being of Sec. 14, Town 1, Range 12 within said town, which said highway is described, as follows:

Beginning at the point where the Beloit and Janesville road crosses the section line between Sections 10 and 15, Town of Beloit running thence East along the North side of said section line through the lands of Barnes, Elfendahl and Merrill to the corner of Sections 10, 11, 14, 15; thence East on the North side of the section line between Sections 11 and 14 to a point two rods East of said section corner through the lands of Ross and the said highway is laid out the width of two rods and we did at the time of making said order assess the damages to the owners of real estate over or through which said highway is laid and the advantages of such highway to the applicant. Therefore as follows to wit: To Alexander Barnes on the middle part of South half of South half of Southeast quarter (see No. 14) except one half acre belonging to Elfendahl. We have assessed the sum of \$62 as such damages. To Henry Elfendahl on the middle part South half of the South half of the Southeast quarter of Section 10. We have assessed the sum of \$78 as such damages and to Henry Schmidt the said applicant we hereby assess the advantages of said highway \$140.
