Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town for the discontinuance of a highway which said highway is set forth and described in said application as follows:

Beginning at the center of Section 9; thence running North one mile more or less to a road running East and West through North Sections 3 and 4 at a point near the center of Section 3; said road bordering on lands owned by the names of E. L. Woodruff, Osmond, Stenn Est., Daniel Emerson, S. Sennett and John Jackson.

We the undersigned supervisors met on the 4th day of June, 1900 and made out an notice and fixed thereon a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application; and did meet on the 19th day of June, 1900 at two o'clock P.M. at the house of Patrick McKeon, it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice and having first been satisfied that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to the occupants of said lands through which the said highway passes; and the said notice had so been posted up in three public places in said town ten days previous to the time our our said meeting in the manner required by law. We did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway and did hear any and all reasons offered for or against the discontinuance. Thereof, it was our opinion that the public good would be promoted by keeping said highway open.
