

Order for Laying out a Road July 14th 1853

We, the undersigned Supervisors in and for the town of Fulton, County of Rock and State of Wisconsin do hereby certify that we on the application of six or more freeholders as residents of said town, asking for the laying out of a public highway in said town, caused notices in writing to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town, fixing therein the time when and the place where we would meet to decide upon the aforesaid application and also specifying in said notices as near as practicable the road proposed to be laid out and the several tracts of land through which the same might pass, which notices were posted up at least ten days before the time fixed therein for said meeting. And we do further certify that being fully satisfied by the affidavit of one of the applicants that all the notices required by law to be given to occupants, were given pursuant to Statute; we are this 14th day of July A.D. 1853, it being the specified time in said notices for said meeting, met at the hour and place therein named, and proceeded personally to examine said proposed highway, heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same, and decided that said proposed highway to be made, which Survey is as follows; to wit: Beginning on the County line (19) nineteen chains and thirty links west of the quarter post on the South line of Section thirty four (34) in the town of Albion, twelve links west of a large White Oak on said line; thence running South 2° East 18 chains; thence South 13° East 6 chains; thence South 13½° East 15 chains; thence running South 4½° West 9.50 chains thence South 37° West 7.79 chains to the West line of Section three (3) in the town of Fulton; thence on said West line of said Section 3 in said town of Fulton, South 20,24 chains to the North side of the Depot grounds belonging to the Milwaukee & Mississippi Rail Road Co. And now therefore we the Supervisors aforesaid in and for said town of Fulton do on this 14th day of July A.D. 1853 order and declare the above described highway to be a public highway four rods wide, and we do further order the same to be kept open as such pursuant to Statute.
