Health Department Report

COVID Response Update

Katrina Harwood shared a slideshow of the representation of the work that the Health Department is involved in for the county-wide COVID-19 response. For testing, the Health Department is continuing to provide staff support and communication for the Wisconsin National Guard (WING) staffed testing site at Blackhawk Technical College. Statewide, there has been less testing occurring at WING sites and the state Health Department is looking at the future of community-based testing sites throughout the state. Rock County will have WING support until at least May 27th. One of the main components to the response is to complete case investigations and contact tracing for people who have positive test results. Another large component of the response is vaccinations. Vaccine eligibility is open to all Wisconsin residents over the age of 16, beginning on April 2nd. Alison Chouinard from the Rock County Public Health Department is serving as the Vaccine Coordinator and is leading the Vaccine Advisory Committee. There is also a vaccine transportation subcommittee. The Environmental Health Division continues to provide support to businesses on the mask order and the phased reopening guidance.

The following pieces below go along with the different categories of the COVID-19 response.

Communications: Coordinated by Jessica Turner from the Rock County Public Health Department. Board members and community members are encouraged to watch the weekly media briefing, which can be viewed on the Rock County Public Health Department's Facebook page every Thursday at 11 a.m.

Public Health Orders and Guidance: The current mask mandate is enforced by Rock County and is ongoing through May 5th. The phase reopening guidance will be updated after that date.

Surveillance: Nick Zupan provided the Board members with the current COVID-19 data.

Debra Kolste asked about the comparison between the number of positive cases last year at this time vs. the number of positive cases this year at the same time. Nick Zupan responded accordingly.

Supervisor Davis asked about the effects of mask wearing against the flu numbers this year. Nick Zupan responded accordingly.

RCPHD Program Spotlight

2019 Annual Report

- Licensed facilities
 - o Rock County permits over 1,000 facilities (restaurants, pools, lodging, campgrounds, etc.)
 - Overall goal is to reduce illness and injuries
 - o In 2019, Rock County received a grant to perform a foodborne illness risk assessment
- Childhood Lead Poisoning
 - o In Rock County, more than half of the homes were built before 1960, many of which still contain lead
 - Many children do get referred for blood tests
 - o If care is needed, coordination is done by a Public Health Nurse and an Environmental Health employee
 - o Healthy Homes Lead Risk Assessment is done
 - o Rock County Public Health Department partners with the City of Janesville on many home rehab projects and programs
 - o Occasionally, lead abatement orders are sent, if necessary
 - o Several different funding sources are available to help pay for repairs
- Immunizations (non-COVID)
 - o Michelle Bailey presented on various immunization program objectives

Executive Summary

While the American food supply is among the safest in the world, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimates that there are about 48 million cases of foodborne illness annually - the equivalent of sickening 1 in 6 Americans each year. And each year these illnesses result in an estimated 128,000 hospitalizations and 3,000 deaths. The Rock County Public Health Department (RCPHD) regulates and inspects approximately 900 food establishments annually in order to reduce the potential for foodborne illnesses in our community. FDA Voluntary National Retail Food Regulatory Program Standards have been developed to help ensure that local regulatory food programs conduct inspection and investigation activities in a uniform and comprehensive manner. RCPHD will be utilizing this FDA training grant to attend approved regional and national trainings relevant to food safety and the Standards. These trainings will allow staff to obtain knowledge and skills that will assist in meeting the Standards, as well as providing partner food establishment owners and operators with the latest information on food safety practices.

WHEREAS, COVID-19 response activities such as case investigation, contact tracing, outbreak investigation, testing, and vaccinations have continued to require additional workforce capacity; and,

WHEREAS, Rock County Public Health Department has been awarded a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Diseases (ELC) program to enhance capacity; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Public Health Department will utilize the additional funding to enhance ability to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic, which involves identifying people who have COVID-19; conducting case investigations, contact tracing, and outbreak investigations; maintaining morbidity and mortality surveillance; coordinating and providing counter measures (including vaccinations); and working with healthcare systems to manage and monitor system capacity; and,

WHEREAS, the funding is for the time period of October 1, 2020 to December 31, 2022.
