**Proclaiming May 12 – May 18, 2013 as Law Enforcement Memorial Week and May 15 as Peace Officers' Memorial Day**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that we call upon all citizens of Rock County and upon all patriotic, civic and educational organizations to observe the week of May 12 – May 18, 2013 as Law Enforcement Memorial Week with appropriate ceremonies and observances in which all may join in commemorating law enforcement officers, past and present, who, by their faithful and loyal devotion to their responsibilities, have rendered a dedicated service to their communities and, in so doing have established for themselves an enviable and enduring reputation for preserving the rights and security of all citizens.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that we call upon all citizens of Rock County to observe Wednesday, May 15 as Peace Officers’ Memorial Day in honor of those law enforcement officers who, through their courageous deeds, have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their community or have become disabled in the

performance of duty, and let us recognize and pay respect to the survivors of our fallen heroes.”

Supervisor Knudson moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Wiedenfeld.

Supervisor Brill and Beaver said this resolution should include all law enforcement in Rock County.

ADOPTED.
