We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin Territory have this 23rd day of March 1846 laid out and established a public highway in said town of the width of four rods. Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 1 in T. 3 N., R. 12 E. and running thence South 189 ch. 50 l. on the line between Ranges 12 and 13 East and to the intersections of the road leading from Humes Bridge to Mt. Zion; and now we the Commissioners as aforesaid in and for said town, do on the day and year first above written order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.

-Notes of a survey of a road laid out by the undersigned Commissioners of Highways of the Towns of Janesville and Rock in the County of Rock and Territory of Wisconsin.

Beginning at a point on the line between Ranges 11 and 12 East where T. 2 and 3 North in R. 12 E. corner together on said line; and running East on the line between said townships and between the Towns of Janesville and Rock Aforesaid to a point 8 chains distant and West from the corner of Sections 34, 33, 3 & 4 in said townships; thence South 79° 45' E. 8 chains and 50 links and over Scoville's Creek; thence North 75° 30' E. four chains and 60 links back to the line between the townships aforesaid; thence East on said line to the Western boundary of the Village of Rockport said road is four rods in width extends two rods on each side of the line described.
