We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin Territory have this 3rd day of January 1846 laid out and established a public highway in said town: Beginning at the Northeast corner of Sec. 6 in T. 3 N., R. 13 E and running from thence South 15° 30' W. 78. ch. 71 links to a post on Sec. 6; thence S. 23° W. 25 ch. 33 l. to a post standing on Sec. 7; thence S. 48° W. 7 ch. 54 links to a post standing on the line between Harvey Story and John Gibbs; thence S. 8° E. on Sec. 7, 18 and 19, two miles 35 chains and 50 links to the center of the road leading from Janesville to Ft. Atkinson; said road is laid four rods wide and now we the Commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written order and declare the road as above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
