Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 35, Town 3 N., R. 12 E. and running thence on section line between Sec's. 34 and 35 South one mile to the town line between Towns 2 and 3 Range 12 East. Said road to be two rods wide - one rod on each side of said section line.

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written, order and declare the road above described to be a public highway, and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to state, or statute.
