We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Janesville,  
County of Rock and State of Wisconsin. have this 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 1849  
laid out and established a public highway in said town. Beginning  
at the section line between Sections 1 and 2 of Town of Janesville  
and distant 17 and 8/100 rods from the section corner of 12 and said  
highway running from said point. thence South 75° West 161 rods 32/100  
to the quarter stake on the section line between Sections 2 and 11;  
thence on said section line West to the section corner 162 rods;  
thence West on the section line between Sections 3 and 10, 61 rods  
to or near the center of the public highway leading from Morses  
Prairie to the Milwaukee and Territorial Road, said road to be four  
rods wide.

And now the Commissioner and supervisors in and for said town  
of Janesville do on the year and day first above written, order and  
declare the road above described to a be a public highway, and we do  
further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
