We the Supervisors of the Town of Janesville, Rock County, Wisconsin, do certify that on the application of six or more freeholders of said town, asking for the laying out a public highway in Town of Janesville as follows to wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 2 on sections lines 2 and 3, 10 and 11 running 95 chains 50 links on said line".

That we caused notices to be posted up in writing in three of the most public places in said town for Janesville specifying the road above mentioned purposed for highway, and the time and place at which notices were posted up at least ten days before said meeting and we do further certify that being fully satisfied that such notices required by law had been given pursuant to statute.

We on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1851 it being the time and place in said notices met at the hour and place therein mentioned. examined and caused the above survey to be made of said purposed highway, heard all the reasons for and against laying out the same, we are of the opinion that such highway is necessary and proper and proceeded to lay out the same pursuant to statute.

And now we the Supervisors aforesaid in and for said Town of Janesville do on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1851 order and declare the a-bove road to be a public highway, four rods wide. And we do further order the same to be kept in as such pursuant to statute.
