At a joint meeting of the Supervisors of the Towns of Janesville and Harmony held on Saturday the 29th day of April 1854 for the purpose of determining what part of the highway running between said towns shall be made and kept in repair by each town. It was resolved that the Town of Harmony shall make and keep in repair that portion of the road commencing at the North line of said town and running one mile South. That the Town of Janesville shall make and keep in repair the remaining portion of said road terminating at the road leading from Humes Bridge to Mount Zion in the County of Rock.
