Application having been made to us the undersigned supervisors of the Town of Janesville dated May 29<sup>th</sup>, 1856 by ten freeholders and residents of said town in writing to lay out and establish a public highway in said town commencing at the Northeast corner of the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 20; thence South on or near the line to the Magnolia Road, in pursuance of said application, we the said supervisors prepared notices under our signature dated June 6<sup>th</sup>, 1856 that we would meet at the house of James Turnbull on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the same month, June 1856 at nine o'clock in the forenoon to view the proposed road and if deemed expedient by us to lay out and established the same. We met at the house of the said Turnbull on said 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1856 agreeable to said notices and after becoming satisfied that said notices were posted up in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to said 20<sup>th</sup> day of June and a that a copy of said notice had been served on all of the owners or occupants of lands over which said road we asked to be laid. We the said Supervisors proceeded to view said proposed road and after hearing all that
