We the undersigned Commissioners of Highways in and for the Town of Johnstown, Rock County, Wisconsin have this second day of April A.D., 1847 laid out a public highway in said town commencing at the South line of said town at the termination of a public highway in the Town of Bradford, one mile West of the East line of said Town of Johnstown to run North on the section line to intersect a public highway running East and West half a mile North of the line of said town. Said road to be four rods wide.
