ROAD SOUTH OF LIMA SECTION #3

Survey of a public highway made this 23rd day of March
A.D. 1848.

Beginning on the North line of the town $37\frac{1}{2}$ links West of
the quarter line of Section 3; thence Southerly 43.79 chains
to center quarter stake of Section 3; thence East $37\frac{1}{2}$ links;
thence Southerly 39.50 chains to quarter stake on North side
of Section 10; thence South 79.65 chains to quarter stake
on the North side of Section 15; thence South 80 chains to
quarter stake on the North side of Section 22; thence Southerly
to quarter stake on the North side of Section 27, 80 chains;
thence Southerly 6.15 chains to the United State road being laid
three rods in width line in the middle by order of the Commissioners
of Highways of the Town of Johnstown of Rock Territory of Wisconsin.

The Magnetic bearing being S. 8° E.
