TOWN LINE ROAD

JOHNSTOWN AND HARMONY

This will certify that the supervisors of the Towns of Johnstown and Harmony being duly petitioned by six freeholders of the Town of Harmony and has given lawful notice of the meeting thereof after having met and examined the road and satisfied ourselves that lawful notice being given we do lay out and establish a public highway - Commencing at a section corner on the Southeast corner of Section 36 and Southwest corner of Section 31 and running North between Section 25 and 30 and 24 and 29, 18 and 12 and 7 to the middle of what is called the Madison and Chicago Road. This road is laid out four rods wide.

The supervisors of the Town of Johnstown and Harmony having liad out a town line between Johnstown and Harmony this day and do hereby agree that the Town of Johnstown shall pay one half of the damage allowed and the Town of Harmony the other half also agree that the Town of Johnstown shall open and maintain the the South of said road between Section 36 and 31, 25 and 30 and half of 24 and 19 and the Town of Harmony shall open and maintain the North half being Section 12 and 7, 13 and 18 and the North half of Sec. 24 and 19.
