Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Johnstown for the altering of a highway hereinafter described; we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 23rd day of September A.D. 1887 meet at the house of Hiram James in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed upon by us for that purpose, did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against altering the same, did then and there decide upon said application and determined to alter said highway as hereinafter described, having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application; and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be given to all the occupants of the land through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting.

It is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby altered as follows to wit: Pursuant to said application whereof an accurate survey has been made, which is as follows to wit: Commencing at a stake surrounded by one limestone and two hard head stones, set in the center of the highway running from Johnstown Center to Milton at a point that is South 10 chains and 11 links from the Northwest corner of Section 20, Town 3, North of Range 14 East; running thence North 42° 45' West 14 chains to a stake surrounded by 2 limestone and one hard head, set 43 links about Southeast from North line of said Section 20; thence North 46° 30' West 31 chains and 50 links to a stake surrounded by two flat limestone and one hard head; thence North 46° 30' West, the same course as last 13 chains and 25 links to a stake surrounded by 3 hard heads set 5 chains South of East and West quarter line and 5 chains West of North and South quarter line of Section 17, Town 3, North of Range 14 East.

The variation of needle assumed as 7° 45' East. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.
