Whereas upon application of six freeholders residing in said Town of Johnstown for the altering of a highway which said proposed altering is described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of land owned by Angelet Wesse or Morse in the highway known as the County House road hence running Northerly to a stake in the center of the highway between lands owned by Jos. Gentle, and Lamitan (Robert) the North, Jos. McFaslin Est. and M.Benigan Est. on the South. Said corner being in the center of section 15, Town 3, Range 14 East in all one mile.

We the undersigned supervisors di on the 3rd day of May 1886 make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet at the 14th day of May 1886 at nine o'clock in the forenoon of said day at the house of Wm. Sheridan, it being the time and place fixed by us in such notice and having first been satisfied by due proof that the notice Forsaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all occupants of said lands through which said highway may pass by serving each of them personally with such notice as by copy thereof left at the usual place of abide of each occupant of said lands and also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting in the manner required by law we did then and there proceed to personally examine said highway and hearing and all reasons that were offered for or against the same and it being my opinion that the public goodwill thereby be promoted did decide to alter said highway as hereinafter described. Now therefore pursuant to said application we the said supervisors do hereby order and determine that the said highway be and the same is hereby altered as follows to wit: Commencing at the Southwest corner of land owned by Angelett Morse hence running Westerly one half mile and East one mile, hence North 80 rods, hence Northerly 80 rods and West one rod.
