Recites in part---commencing at the quarter post on the East side of Section 12 in Town 2 North of Range 13 East and running thence North 88° 50' West, 57 chains; thence North 80° 15' West, 3 chains; thence North 88° 50' West, 20 chains to the line of sections; thence South 50 links to the quarter post between Section 11 and 12; thence North 87° 53' West, 80 chains to the quarter post between Section 10 and 11; thence North 89° 30' West, 80 chains to the quarter post between Sections 9 and 10. The above as per survey of Orrin Densmore.

And now, therefore, we do order the aforesaid described highway laid out and established according to the provisions of the statute.

Recites in part---it is hereby ordered and determined that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of four rods. Commencing at the East line of Section 11 half way between the North and South line and running in a Westerly direction on the half section line through Sections 11 and 10 and 9 being a distance of three miles according to survey.
