

No. 4 Also one other Highway commencing 65 links East of the North West Corner of Section No. 3 Town 3 North of Range No. 10 East upon the North line of said Section 3, and run thence South 2° West 13 chains and 50 links to the Section line between Section 3 & 4 and South along said Section line 30 chains to a small bur oak tree Marked H; thence S. 44° West 6 chains and 4 links to a small bur oak tree marked H, thence S. 21° W. 11 chains and 50 links to a stake thence South 16° East 9 Chains to a stake thence South 5° West 11 chains to a bur oak stake thence South 40° East 9 chains & 89 links to a bur oak tree standing in the East line of Section No. 10 thence south along the Section line 7 chains & 12 links to the quarter post upon the line between Section 10 & 9 on South along the Section line 40 chains to the Corner of Section 10, 9, 15, 16 and South along the line between Section 15 & 16, 32 chains & 36 links to the center of the Beloit & Madison Highway the course & distances is the center of the Highway, variation of the Magnetic Needle 8° East.

Also one other Highway commencing at the quarter post upon the line between section 3 & 4 in Town 3 North of range 10, E. and run thence South 41° West 32 chains & 26 links to a bur oak tree Marker H thence South 54° 30° West 13 chains & 12 links to the center of the Highway; running past John W. Gowners to Norton & Harris Saw Mill the corners & distances the center of the road. Variation of the magnetic needle 8° East.

Also one other Highway commencing in the Center of the Highway upon the bridge south of Harris & Mortons Saw Mill that the water passes under from the south bulk head of the Mill Dam & run thence South 8° East as the Needle now points, 31 chains & 62 links to the center of the Highway running East & West through the Center No. 10 Town 3 North of Range No. 10 East; thence west along the center of said road 8 chains & 50 links; thence South 6° $30'$ East as the needle now points, 11 chains thence south 26° $30'$ West 15 chains 22 links to a bur oak tree marked H; thence South 13° $30'$ West 53 chains & 56 links to the West line of Section No. 16 thence South along said section line 3 chains & 21 links to the quarter post on South along said Section line 18 chains & 12 links from the quarter post to the center of the Territorial Road running from Janesville to Sugar River the corners & distances being the center of the Highway Given under my hand this 23rd day of March 1847. road 4 rods wide, the line being Hanson B. Vaughan-Surveyor the center of road. March 23, 1847
