Road from S.E. Corner of Sec 21, thence West to the Town Line.

This day surveyed under the direction of the commissioners of highways of the Town of Magnolia running as follows to wit:

commencing at the corners of Sections 21,22,27,28, in Town 3, North of range No. 10 E. and thence West along the line between 21, & 28 twenty chains, to the South West corner of the East half of the South East quarter of said Section 21; thence South 68° 30 W. 13 chains to a stake standing North 12° W. 86 Links from a Burr oak tree 10 inches through (Marked N. 12° W. 86 links) thence South 86° West 13 chains to a stake standing N.70° W. 85 links from a burr oak tree 12 inches through marked N.70° W. 85 links, thence North 45° W. 7 chains 90 links to a stake standing on the section line between sections 21 and 28; thence west along said section line 29 chains 33 links to the corner of sections 20,21,28 and 29 and West along the section line between sections 20,29,19 and 30 to west line of the Town, the line being the center of the **same**. Variation of the magnetic needle 8°.

Road from Center of the town- North 1½ Miles

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Magnolia all the commissioners having met and deliberated on the subject embraced in this order. It is ordered and determined by the said commissioners that a Highway be laid out in said Town of the width of four rods and the said commissioners have caused a survey thereof to be made as follows; the centerline of the Highway is to commence at the S. East Corner of section 16 and run thence North on said section line to the quarter post on said Section line between Sections, 9 and 10.
