

Record of E. Miller's Petition

To the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Magnolis the undersigned inhabitants and freeholders of said town respectfully petition that the Highway running from the 1/8th stake on South side of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 30 and from the 1/4 stake on the S. W. Corner of said 1/4 Section west to the County line be taken up and relaid so as to run from said 1/8th stake on said 1/4 stake as you may judge best to the present in the center of the Albany Road where said road in Green County strikes the County line aforesaid to wit: a few rods North of Mr. Brewers house., if the Bluff however should be in the line then to angle so as not to go over any part of said Bluff, also to lay the following to wit: commencing at a point 8.57 chains west of the 1/8 stake on the South side of the S.W. 1/4 of stake 33 and running thence N. 70 E. 9.11 Chains thence N. 35 1/4 E. 8.25 chains to a Burr Oak tree (10) inches; thence N. 34 1/4 E. 17.58 chains to a Burr Oak (18 in.) thence N. 17 3/4 E. 16.76 to 1/4 line thence N. 25 1/2 E. 15.80 thence N. 20 1/4 E. 10.54 chains thence N. 10 E. 11.15 chains thence N. 26 3/4 E. 2 chains and thence N. 58 E. 6.45 chains to the Center of the Highway, said Highway to be 4 rods wide. Record of Alteration

At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Town of Magnolia Rock County, Wisconsin held on the 12th of March A.D. 1850 to take in consideration the petition of Geo. Miller and others inhabitants of said Magnolia, for an alteration in the Janesville and Albany road. It was ordered that the following alteration be made in said road to wit: Commencing at a point S. 89 1/2 W. distant 3 Chains from the 1/4 post on the East side of Section 17 and running thence from said 1/4 post S. 30 East 16 Chains and 9 links to the termination point in the center of the road, as it now runs from Janesville to Albany; from said termination point a Burr oak tree 12 inches in diameter and marked on the South west side -N.41 1/2 East 59 links and another Burr Oak 15 inches in diameter and marked on the East Side bears N. 78 1/4 West distant 1 chain and fifty five links said courses and distances are the center of said Highway and the width is four rods variation of the magnetic needle is 7.25. And that so much of said Janesville and Albany road as now lays between this beginning and termination of the above mentioned surveyed line is hereby taken up and forever discontinued.
