At a meeting of the Supervisors of said Town agreeable to previous notice and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out in said Town of the width of four rods lying in the South West corner of Section No. One in said Town running thence East on the Section line between Sections one and twelve to the East line of said Section running between the lands of Amos Lewis and Mr. Wood for eighty rods thence through Martin Lees land half a mile on the South side or in Section Twelve and eighty rods on the North side in Section one thence eighty rods between Amos Lewis and Theodore Lee to the Section line aforesaid.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands at Magnolia on this 13th day of Jan. 1855.

At a meeting of the Supervisors, all being notified of said Town, agreeable to previous notice and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out in said Town of the width of four rods as follows; the center line of said road is to commence on the Janesville and Albany road where the road leaves, the quarter line between Charles F. Goodwin and Joseph Prentice and continue the road West on said quarter line until the said quarter line intersects the above said road and also that said Supervisors discontinue the old road that now runs past the house of Joseph Prentice.
