

Whereas on the application of six freeholder of the Town of Magnolia in said County for the laying out of a highway herein after described we the undersigned Supervisors of said Town did on the seventh day of July A.D. 1860 meet at the House of B. H. Cronk in said Town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against the same did determine to layout such Highway as herein after described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which to meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such Highway having five days previous to our meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which such highway passes and such Notice having also been posted up in three public places in said Town ten days before the time of our said meeting it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid, pursuant to such application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Beginning eighty rods East of Section corner of Sections 28 and 33 in the center of the Road between said sections running thence North on the half quarter line one mile the said road to be four rods in width.

Whereas an application being made by six freeholders of the town of Magnolia in the County of Rock also by six freeholders of the Town of Albany in the County of Green for the laying out of a highway described as follows: Commencing at the North East corner of the Town of Decatur running thence North to the North West corner of Section N° 31 in the Town of Magnolia on the West line of said Section the said highway to run on the Town line between the Town of Albany in the County of Green the line to be the survey of said highway and the same is established four rods wide and the Supervisors of said Towns have awarded Theo. H. Ash, fourteen dollars.
