At a meeting of the Supervisors of the town of Magnolia agreeable to previous notice and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out in said Town of the width of four rods and have caused a Survey thereof to be made as follows viz: The center line of the said highway is to commence at the South East corner of Section 26 running thence south one mile between Section 35 and 36 to the town line road between the towns of Spring Valley and Magnolia.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set out hands at Magnolia this 6th day of June A.D. 1868.

We the undersigned Freeholders of the town of Magnolia petition to the Supervisors of said town to have a highway taken up commencing at the South West corner of the East Half of the South East quarter of section 16 running thence a North Westerly course to a point near the West line of the South West quarter of the S South East quarter of Section 16.

Also to lay out a highway commencing at the point referred to above where the highway to be taken up terminates and running in a South Easterly direction as near as may be the line of the State Road running East and West by William Morman's house.
