Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Milton for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 29th day of August 1862 meet at the house of Lester T. Rogers in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose; did proceed to examine personally such highway, and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same did then and there decide upon such application and determine to lay out said highway as herein-after described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting, it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to said application thereof. Whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Beginning in the center of the town line road between Milton and Fulton at the place where the Fulton and Indian Ford road makes a junction with the said town line road and at the stake S 7° 15' E. and 16.59 chains from a stake in the North west corner of the South west quarter of section 18 in the town of Milton and thence running N. 84° 15' E. and 8.14 chains to a stake in the center of the old Territorial Road. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway; and the same is established four rods in width.

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Milton for the altering of a highway hereinafter described we the under signed supervisors of said town did on the first day of December A.D. 1863 meet at the house of J. M. Morse in said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against altering the same did then and there decide upon such application and determine to alter said highway as hereinafter described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed herein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting; it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that the highway running from Janesville to Fort Atkinson known as a Territorial road be altered and have caused a survey hereof to be made as follows viz: Beginning in the center of the above mentioned Janesville and Fort Atkinson road two rods North of the line between the North East and South East quarters of section 15 in town 4 range 13 East and from thence running North 85° East (not regarding the variations of the needle to the line between sections 14 & 15, 70 rods and 5 links; thence running North along the section line 84 rods until it intersects the above mentioned Janesville and Fort Atkinson road in said town, and have also determined that so much of the said territorial road as lies between the points of beginning and ending in said alterations, shall be and herein is vacated.
