Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Milton for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described, we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 14th day of May A.D. 1883 met at the office of L. T. Rogers, Town Clerk of said town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application (it being the time and place fixed upon by us for that purpose) did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such reasons as were offered for and against laying out the same, did then and there decide upon such application and did determine to lay out said highway as hereinafter described, having required by law first a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and the same was served upon owners of the land through which said highway runs except such as signed the petition for the laying out of said highway said notice having been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting. It is now therefore ordered and determined and we do now hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to such application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point in the center of the highway on the South line of Section 27 of the town of Milton (known as the sugar river road) 12 chains and 17½ links East from the quarter stone in the South West Corner of said Section 27, thence North from said point and parallel with the west line of said Section through the lands of F. M. Smalley, A. G. Asmond, C. M. & St. P. R.R. Co., F. C. Bnten, J. F. Kelley and M. F. Bankson, to a point in the center of the highway known as the Chicago and Madison Road, which point is 12 chains and 17½ links East from the West line of said Section, said highway to be three rods in width its entire length, and the said described line to be the center thereof as by us established.
