ORDER FOR HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS NUMBER EIGHT

Between Sec. 16, 9 & 4 and 15, 10 & 3

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark met at the house of William Crippen in said Town on the 30th day of June A.D. 1846 at nine o'clock A.M. to take into consideration the subject of the petition of Martin Green and 13 others for the laying of a Highways when it was proved to the satisfaction of said Commissioners that notice of such meeting had been given as the law requires they proceeded to survey the ground on the route petitioned for.

Commencing at the South East corner of Section 16 in Township No. 1 North of Range No. 10 East - thence running North on the section line to the quarter post on the West side of section 10 - thence North on the section line 30 chains - thence North 13 degrees East 32 chains - thence North $38\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 21 chains and 32 links - thence North on the section line 3 chains and 80 links to the quarter post on the West side of Section(3) three - thence North on the Section line to the North West corner of Section 3 it being the North line of Township 1 Range 10.

We order and determine that the above description line be the center line of a Highway of four rods in width.
Variation of the needle $6\frac{1}{2}$ degrees.
