ORDER OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS NUMBER SEVEN

We the Commissioners Highways for the Town of Newark met at the dwelling house of David Polley in said Town on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1846 at nine o'clock A.M. to take into consideration the subject of the Petition of David Polley and ten others for the laying of a highway. When it was proved to the satisfaction of said Commissioners that notice of such meeting had been given as the law requires they proceeded to survey the ground on the route petitioned for as follows:

Beginning on Picatonic and Madison Road where a straight line 20 chains South of the South line of Section 1 Town 1 Range 11 crosses said road - thence running West 67 chains and 88 links - thence North  $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West 7 chains and 84 links - thence North  $59\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West 29 chains and 60 links - thence West on the section line 2 chains and 76 links to the quarter section post on the south side of section 2 Town 1 Range 11 - thence West on the section line to the Southwest corner of Section 4 - thence North on the section line to the quarter section post on the West side of Section 4.  
Variation of the compass  $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$

We order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Highway four rods in width.
