ORDER OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS NUMBER ELEVEN

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark met at the house of Archibald P. Ross in said Town on the 11th day of February A. D. 1847 at nine o'clock A. M. to take into consideration the subject of the petition of the Norwegians for the laying of a Highway when it was proved to the satisfaction of said Commissioners that notice of such meeting had been given as the law requires they proceeded to survey the ground on the route petitioned for

Commencing at a point 24 chains and 80 links East of the South West corner of Section 4 in Town One Range Eleven - thence running North $40\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 50 chains - thence North 52° West 32 chains and 20 links - thence West 130 chains to the West line of Range Eleven
Variation of the needle $63\frac{3}{4}$ degrees

We order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Highway of four rods in width.
