ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS OF HIGHWAYS NUMBER THIRTEEN
ALTERATION OF DISTILLERY ROAD

We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark met at the house of Zebulon L. Sargent in said Town on the 12th day of March A. D. 1847 at ten o'clock A. M. to take into consideration the subject of the Petition of J. W. Noggle and ten others for an alteration of the Highway running West from Goodhues Distillery - where it was proved to the satisfaction of said Commissioners that such notice of their meeting had been given as the law requires they proceeded to examine the ground on the route petitioned for and caused a survey to make

Commencing at an angle on the section line on the West side of Section 33 Town One Range Eleven - thence running North $55\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 40 chains - thence North $69\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West 29 chains and 70 links - thence North $53\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 25 chains and 25 links - thence North $33\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West 71 chains to where it intersects the Beloit and Sugar River Road Variation of the needle $6\frac{3}{4}$ degrees - -

We order and determine that the above described line be the center line of a Highway of four rods in width
