ORDER OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS NUMBER TWO

East & West through middle of Section 12

The Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Newark met at the house of Samuel B. Boss in said Town on the 21 day of April A. D. 1847 at ten o'clock a.m. to take into consideration the subject of the petition of Mr. Williams and others for the laying of a public highway we being satisfied that such notice of our meeting had been given as the law requires we proceeded to survey the ground on the route petitioned for

Commencing at the 1/4 post on the East side of Section 12 Town One Range 11 - thence running West on the 1/4 section line 35 chains thence North $66^{\circ} 15'$ West 48 chains and 20 links to where it intersects a highway that is now laid. Variation of the needle $6^{\circ} 30'$ -six degrees and thirty minutes

And we order and determine that the above described line be the centerline of a highway of four rods in width
